

## LEEDS CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & WAITING PROHIBITION) ORDER 2023 MORLEY 10K RUNNING RACE SUNDAY 8 OCTOBER 2023

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Leeds City Council, as traffic authority for the Leeds Metropolitan District, has today made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, prohibiting the use of certain roads by vehicles to facilitate the holding of the Morley 10k Running Race on Sunday 8 October 2023. The event will require the closure of the roads and wating restrictions shown in the Schedules below and any junction situated along the closed road lengths. The effect of the Order will be that:

No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed on the length(s) of road specified in Schedule 1 below or to wait in the length's road specified in Schedule 2 below whilst the road closures are in place.

(Provided that such prohibition shall not extend to vehicles being used in connection with the relevant event. Emergency access will be maintained for the Police, Fire Brigade and Ambulance purposes and for organisations responsible for dealing with the loss of supplies of gas, electricity, water or electronic communications, to premises in the area and for the removal of any obstruction to traffic.

The Order will come into effect at 08:00 hours on Sunday 8 October 2023 and will continue in force until 11:00 hours Provided That roads will only be closed for as long as necessary to ensure the safety of runners and the public. Where necessary local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate.

The Order will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, any such road.
